

Blackburn Soccer Teams fall to Greenville

The Blackburn College Soccer teams each suffered defeat at the hands of the Panthers of Greenville College on Wednesday in Carlinville. In the 1st game of the afternoon, the Greenville College women controlled the match throughout the day and came away with a 7-0 victory over the Beavers. Greenville outshot the Beavers 45-1. Tara Allen was named the Reno's Pizza M.V.P. for the game for Blackburn. On Saturday the Beavers will host Westminster College in another St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference contest at 1 p.m. Blackburn is 3-6 overall and 1-3 in the SLIAC.

In game two of the doubleheader, the Greenville men outscored the Beavers 4-0 in the 2nd half pulling away to a 7-1 victory in a St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference game. Aaron Guzman's goal, his 8th of the season cut the lead to 3-1 and that closed out the 1st half scoring. Chris Walker was credited with his 6th assist of the season. Greenville outshot Blackburn 45-8 in the contest. Matt Spala was named the Reno's Pizza M.V.P. for the game. Blackburn falls to 6-5 on the season and 1-3 in the SLIAC.
