

Women's Soccer falls to Oakland City University 3-0

The Blackburn College Women's Soccer team dropped a 3-0 decision to the Mighty Oaks of Oakland City University on Wednesday in Carlinville. In a competitive first half Kyndal Thompson broke a scoreless contest with an unassisted goal at 25:46. The Mighty Oaks added two second half goals, the first at 64:40 by Megan Nanney on an assist from Nichole Tsimekles and then finished the scoring at 83:22 on an unassisted goal by Ciara Leslie.

Erika Boeckmann had 12 saves for Blackburn in goal. Oakland City outshot the Beavers 40-4 and also with shots on goal by a 15-2 margin. Blackburn falls to 0-3 on the season, while Oakland City evened its record at 1-1.

Blackburn now has 17 days off until resuming action with a conference game at Fontbonne University on September 26 at 2:00 p.m.
