The Blackburn College 2026 Homecoming & Family Weekend is a time to reconnect, reflect, and celebrate all that makes Blackburn so special. This year's theme, "Blackburn Road Trip" with its full slate of activities, is designed to remind us why "Every Road Leads Back to Blackburn."

Consider what makes road trips so special – exploring history, experiencing small town charms, and the opportunity to enjoy the freedom of the open road with vistas and destinations yet to discover. Add a cooler full of snacks, your favorite soda or pop, favorite tunes on the radio or streaming app, a sense of adventure, and you are on your way.

Your "road trip" back to Blackburn may be by car, plane, train, or bus. You might also get to campus simply by jogging through Carlinville, cutting across the grass, and past the new tennis & racquetball courts.

Historic Route 66, coined The Mother Road, is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2026. Centennial celebrations are being held from Illinois to California. With our beautiful campus resting adjacent to Route 66, we cannot help but blush with a knowing smile that Blackburn College has five major buildings built around this time, including Stoddard Hall (1925), McKinley House (1926), Butler Hall (1928), Hudson Hall (1932), and even Dawes Gymnasium (1938). Each evokes the charm and character of the time it was built, complete with historic red brick and iconic trim, yet each delivers the amenities demanded by today's collegiate audience including air conditioning, updated dorm experiences, recreation areas, and even a glistening new basketball court with digital scoreboards and major athletic complex with the latest equipment.

Homecoming activities this year will offer the opportunity to connect with fellow alums in-town at the Friday evening Scenic Route Bar Crawl, and a daytime Barney's Hide & Squeak Scavenger Hunt. On-campus experiences will include perennial favorites Cocktails and Karaoke, Blackburn 5K, Alumni Awards Luncheon, and various intramural and collegiate sports events. A "Roadside Sale" will feature the artistic talents of alums set in a classic open road format. The Sunday Mass in Clegg Chapel with contemporary artist sing-along is not to be missed!

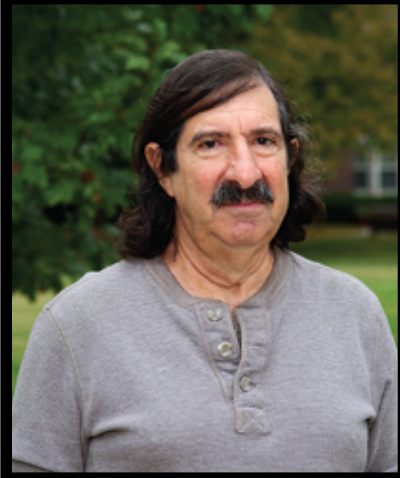
FULL TANK FINALE

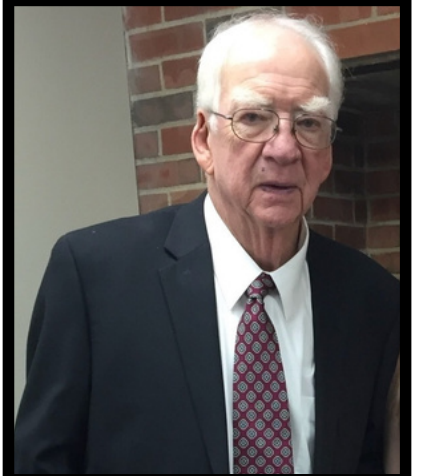

Alumni Award Descriptions

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

The Distinguished Alumni Award is given only once to any one individual who has demonstrated significant contributions to society or a profession (such as receipt of national and/or international honors and/or demonstrated leadership).

ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Alumni Achievement Award is given for demonstrating significant achievement in an individual's personal or public career.

THE HAROLD AND ELIZABETH ZIEGLER SERVICE AWARD

The Harold and Elizabeth Ziegler Service Award is given to an individual who has rendered loyal volunteer service to Blackburn College during the past year.

GIDEON BLACKBURN AWARD

The Gideon Blackburn Award is given to an alumnus/alumna or non-alumnus/alumna who has rendered valuable service to the College in terms of time, money, influence, service, etc. The recipient keeps alive the memory of Dr. Blackburn and the period from 1837 to the time of Dr. Hudson's coming to the College in 1912.

SERVICE TO HUMANITY AWARD

The Service to Humanity Award is intended to recognize those individuals who are giving, or have given of themselves in significant ways for the betterment of humanity, without thought of recognition or compensation. Their efforts have helped to provide support or resources to people who would otherwise go without.

CYNTHIA WILLIAMS LAMAR '73 SERVICE AWARD

The Cynthia Williams Lamar '73 Service Award honors the outstanding work on behalf of the Blackburn College Alumni Association by Cynthia Williams LaMar '73, former Alumni Board member and a past Alumni Board President (1995-1997). The recipient has demonstrated unrelenting efforts, leadership, dedication, and outstanding contributions to the success of the Blackburn College Alumni Association.

ALUMNI EARLY ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Alumni Early Achievement Award honors alumni who have demonstrated significant achievements before the age of 40. The individual(s) must have retained a strong association in some capacity with the College including philanthropic support, volunteer service, and/or an advocacy role. This individual has demonstrated leadership ability or attained prominence in their business, profession, or endeavors. The individual should be involved in community service or civic engagement in some level in his/her local or global community.

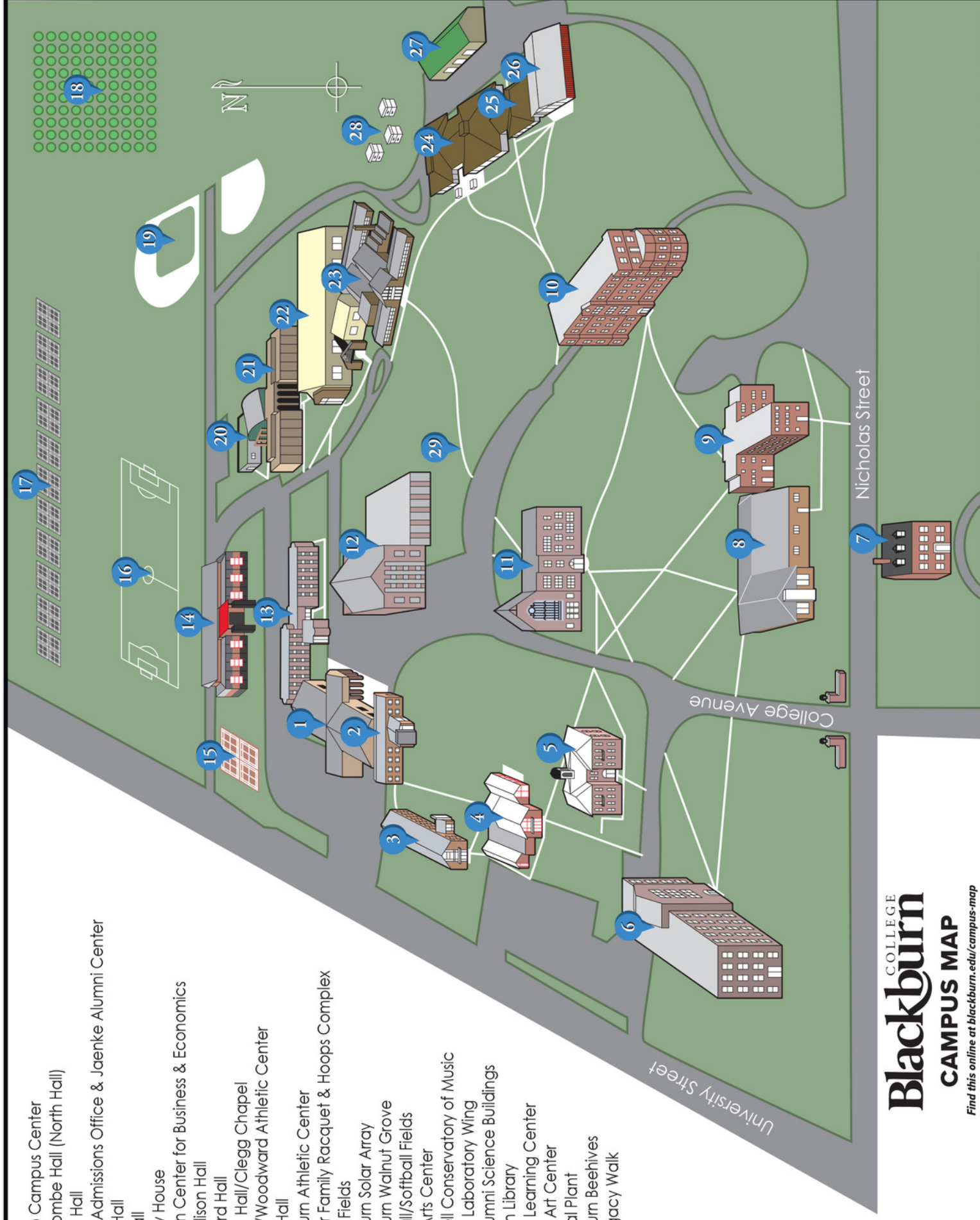
