

Blackburn College Lumpkin Student Success Center COVID-19 Plan

The Lumpkin Student Success Center will be open Monday through Thursday, 8AM-11PM; Friday 8AM-5PM; and Sunday 3PM-11PM. Some portions of Lumpkin may be closed for short durations to allow for extensive cleaning.

- A plexiglass barrier will be installed at the circulation desk.
- All patrons are expected to serve as “supplemental cleaners” by utilizing public cleaning supplies that will be placed in public spaces (i.e., students clean their space when they arrive, and clean their space when they’re finished).
- Masks must be worn by all employees and patrons within the building at all times.
- Six feet of social distancing is required within Lumpkin at all times.
- The space capacity of Lumpkin common areas is limited to 50 persons, not including individuals in classrooms and other enclosed rooms. Sufficient signage will be posted.
- Pedestrian traffic flow will be regulated/structured. The stacks will have directed flow to increase safety.
- Lumpkin will be closed to anyone who is *not* a current College student, faculty, or staff member until further notice.
- All patrons, including faculty and staff, must scan in and out of the building at the circulation desk to track capacity limits.
- All incoming circulation materials will adhere to a 96-hour quarantine and circulation pattern, per Illinois Library Association guidelines.
